

Exchange of foreign and/or Non-EEA (EWR) driving licenses

People, who have a non-EEA (EWR) driving license, are allowed to drive a motor vehicle for six months from the date of entry into Austria. Afterwards an application (at the traffic office of Vienna / Verkehrsamt Wien) and a practical driving test have to be done for an exchange to an Austrian driving license!

For registration at our office:

(16th district Ottakring or 13th district Hietzing) you have to bring the following documents:

- Passport or identity card (or other current and official photo identification)
- Registration Sheet (Address in Austria / Meldezettel)
- Deposit - freely selectable - at least € 50,-

Requirements:

- Main domicile in Austria.
- Proof of residence in the issuing State of at least six months at the time of the purchase (driving test / date of issue) of the driving license.

Documents required for the authorities - traffic office of Vienna / Verkehrsamt Wien:

- Medical report
 - 1 new passport photo
 - Driving License (Original & Copy)
 - Passport (Original & Copy)
 - Registration Sheet (Original & Copy)
 - Residence Permit (if available)
 - possibly report from the driver's license database of the issuing state (embassy)
- ... in some cases, other documents may also be required.

For valid driving licenses from the following countries

NO practical driving test is required:

Andorra, Australien, Guernsey, Bosnien – Herzegowina, Insel Man, Hongkong, Japan, Israel, Jersey, Kanada, Monaco, Makedonien, San Marino, Republik Südafrika, Schweiz, Republik Südkorea (date of issue after 01.01.1997), Serbien, Vereinigte Arabische Emirate, Vereinigte Staaten von Amerika (USA)
